Agenda: To improve the quality of the segregation of Bio Medical Waste Management.

The member of the committee has recommended certain points which are as follows:

1. Biomedical Waste should be segregated at the point of generation by the person who is generating the waste in designated colour coded bin or in container.
2. Biomedical waste and General Waste shall not be mixed. Storage time of waste should be as less or possible so that waste storage, transportation and disposal is done within 48 hours.
3. Phase out use of chlorinated plastic bags (at least 75 microns)
4. No secondary handling or pilferage of waste shall be done at healthcare facility.
5. Only Laboratory and Highly infectious waste shall be pre treated onsite before rough a sending for final treatment or disposal through a CBWTF Operator.
6. Provide bar-code labels on all colour coded bags or containers containing segregated biomedical waste before such waste goes for final disposal through a CBWTF.

The Management of bio - medical waste can overall be summarized in the following steps:

- Waste Segregation in colour coded and barcode labelled bags/ containers at source of generation
- Pre- treat Laboratory and Highly infectious waste
- Intra-mural transportation of segregated waste to central storage area Temporary storage of biomedical waste in central storage area
- Treatment and Disposal of biomedical waste through CBWT

Bin Medical Waste Segregation

Bio Medical waste generated from a healthcare facility is required to be segregated at the point of generation as per the colour coding stipulated under Schedule-I of BMW Rules, 2016 and its subsequent amendment. Following activities to be followed to ensure proper waste segregation:

- Posters/placards for bio-medical waste segregation should be provided in all the wards as well as in waste storage area.
- Adequate number of colour coded bins / containers and bags should be available at the point of generation of bio- medical waste.
- Colour coded plastic bags should be in line with the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 and its subsequent amendments
- Provide Personnel Protective Equipment to the bio-medical waste handling staff.

At the end of the meeting committee also recommended to all the Head of the departments to arrange on class or training every month for the entire Medical and Paramedical employees for the segregation of Bio Medical Waste in Co – ordinance with the CBWTF Operator.
